

INTERNET ACCEPTABLE USE GUIDELINES

- ◆ The Marysville Public Library computers are normally available on a first come, first served basis. If all computers are in use, self-service sign-up at a designated workstation will assign users to a computer on a first available basis.
 - ◆ A Library card and pin number are required to log in to any public computer.
 - ◆ Standard conventions for etiquette on the Internet are to be observed.
 - ◆ Use of profanity and display of sexually explicit graphics are prohibited. Marysville Library reserves the right to terminate any user's session which it deems inappropriate. (see Telecommunications Act of 1996, Title V, subtitle A).
 - ◆ Network resources may not be used for unlawful purposes.
 - ◆ Unauthorized copying of copyright protected materials is not permitted.
 - ◆ You may not use your own software programs on the library's computer. If you wish to save files you may purchase a disk at the circulation desk. Software downloaded from the Internet may contain a virus. The Marysville Public Library is not responsible for damage to a patron's diskette or computer that may occur from patron use of the Library's computer.
 - ◆ Misuse of the Library's computers or Internet access will result in loss of privileges.
 - ◆ Any issues not covered here fall under general library operations.
